Based at universities across the country, Sea Grant works to provide research and outreach that help build and grow innovative businesses along America's oceans and Great Lakes, protect against environmental destruction and natural disasters, and train the next generation of leaders.




# Sea Grant's Legislation

- Ability to accept funding from ANY entity and bring funds into the Treasury
- Encourages partnerships
- Required state program match of 2:1 (33% of entire award) for Sea Grant appropriated funding
- 5% unmatched dollars based on criteria and 5% National administration

# Financial Implications of Legislation

- Strong bi-partisan Hill support
- Allocation to Programs based on merit and competition
- Integrated NOAA research, education, and outreach via Sea Grant network
- Strong NOAA input to Sea Grant priorities










### What NSGO is doing now?


- → Increasing diversity of Federal Partners (and Knauss hosts)

- → "Pushing" all parts of Sea Grant: Education, Extension, and Research




# Sources and Amounts of Passthrough: Grants/Contracts










#### By functional area all passthrough

- Always Connect everyone is looking for someone to talk to!
