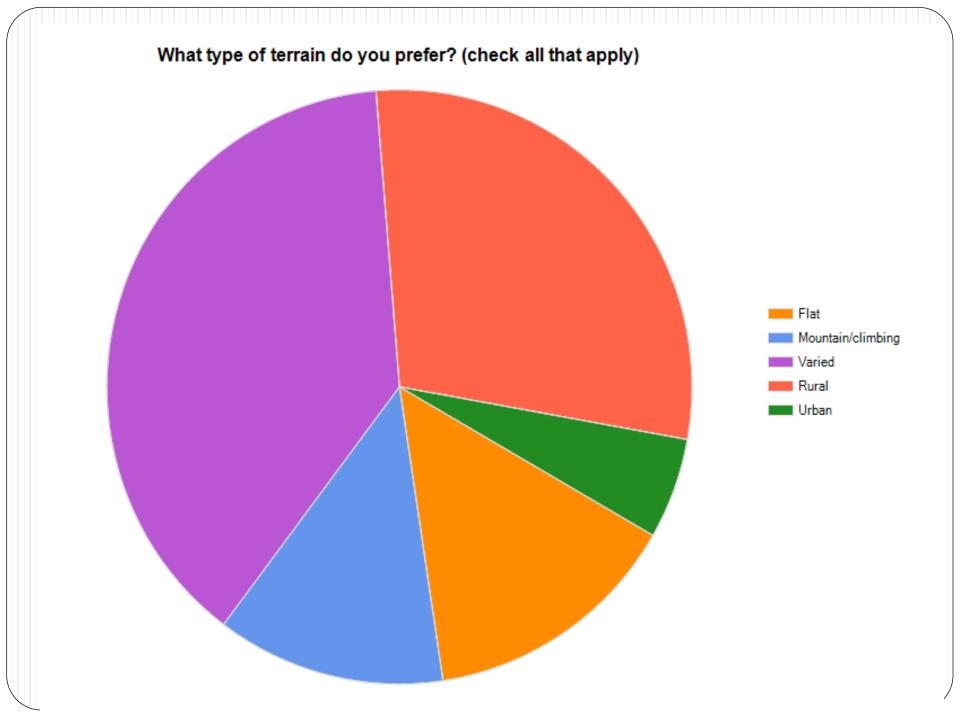


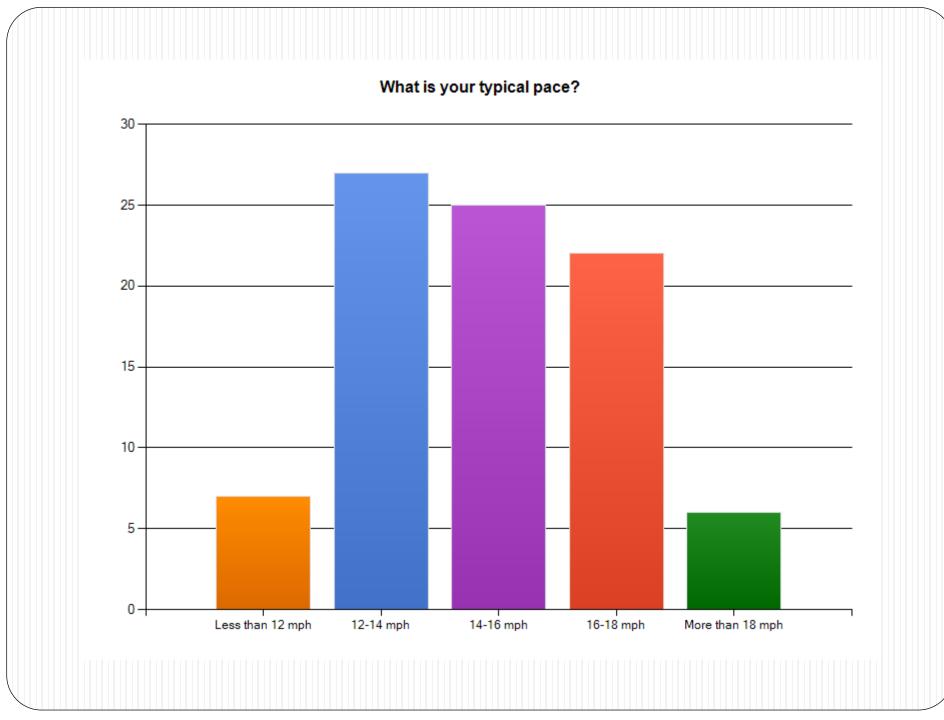
Ride Preferences

Check all that apply about your typical riding preferences.

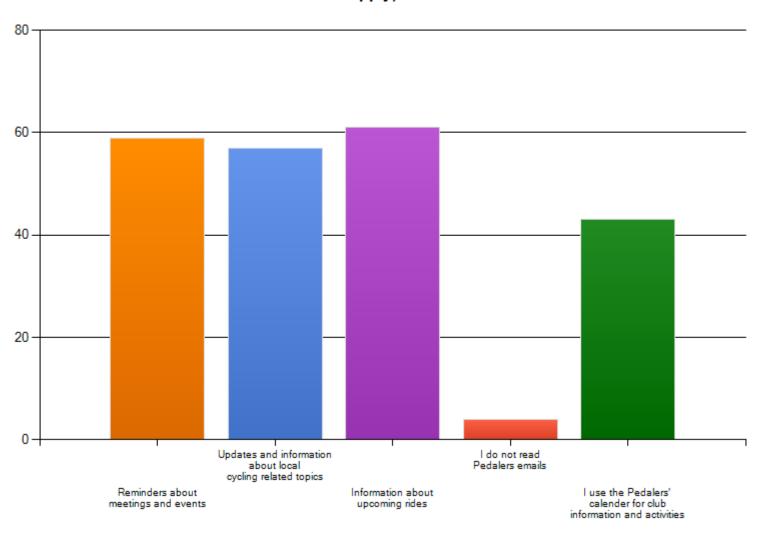








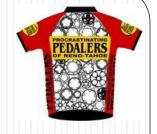
What kinds of information do you like to receive from the news group? (Check all that apply)
